

## **Alternative Certification for Driver Education Instructors**

***June 8-11***  
***June 19, 2009 (lab)***

This Alternative Certification Program for Driver Education Teachers/Teaching Assistants is a state comprehensive field-based program and consists of a minimum of 135 clock hours of driver and traffic safety education. The course consists of a Driver Education Endorsement being added to existing Texas Teaching Certificates or Teaching Assistant certification for non-certified individuals.

The Driver Education Alternative Certification program is being provided over the ESC, Region VI Distance Learning Network. Participants may also attend sessions at the ESC, Region VI Building in Huntsville, TX.

Distance Learning participants will need to contact your district's site facilitator for availability.

Distance Learning participants will participate via Distance Learning the first 4 days of training (June 8, 9, 10 & 11). Other participants will attend all session days on-site in Huntsville, Texas.

All participants must attend the 5th day of training (June 19 - Lab Day) at the ESC, Region VI Professional Development Center in Huntsville, Texas. If enough participants from one area are taking this class, arrangements may be made to schedule last day in your area.

This is Phase 1 of training. Phases 2 & 3 are observation and course instruction and must be completed to complete the course.
